REQUEST FOR COMMENTS ON THE DRAFT DISPUTE MANAGEMENT PLAN FOR COUNTY GOVERNMENTS, NATIONAL GOVERNMENT MINISTRIES, DEPARTMENTS AND AGENCIES (MDAs)

The Nairobi Centre for International Arbitration (NCIA) in conjunction with the Office of the Attorney General and Department of Justice is undertaking a process for development of a Dispute Management Plan (DMP) Manual to implement measures that enhance the avoidance, prevention and speedy resolution of disputes in the Public Sector. The DMP proposes measures, which will lead to the entrenchment and adoption of alternative forms of dispute resolution (ADR) in the structures and operations of Government Ministries, Departments and Agencies (MDAs) and County Governments.

The Manual is designed to support the development and implementation of DMPs by the MDAs and County Governments and encourage flexible, creative, and constructive approaches to dispute resolution.

The Constitution of Kenya, 2010 requires the public to participate in the decision-making process through the submission of comments to the Centre. In view of this, NCIA requests the public to participate in the review of the DMP by submitting their written comments/memoranda through the provided address.
